2010 MERIT AWARDS CALL FOR ENTRIES

The Chicago Building Congress Merit Awards Committee invites entries for CBC's 2010 Merit Awards, which will recognize outstanding construction projects from the past three years in Metropolitan Chicagoland.

CATEGORIES

Entries shall be labeled in one of the following categories for the appropriate judging:

- 1) **New Construction / Chicago**
- 2) **New Construction / Suburbs**
- 3) **Rehab Construction**
- 4) **Construction Under \$10 Million**
- 5) **Infrastructure Construction**
- 6) **Industrial Construction**

ELIGIBILITY

The Merit Awards are open to all types and sizes of projects completed during the 2007, 2008, and 2009 calendar years anywhere in Metropolitan Chicagoland. Nominees may be from any party associated with a project and need not be members of the Chicago Building Congress.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Entries will be judged in all six categories on the basis of the following criteria:

- **Distinctive, functional, or innovative design.**
- **Quality of construction.**
- **Impact of the project upon the community.**
- **Safety record.**

The Awards Committee will employ all of the above criteria in judging each entry.

ENTRY DETAILS

- Member Entry Fee is \$250 for each submission.
- Non-member Entry Fee is \$500 for each submission.
- Each project entry should be shipped to CBC and include the following:

1. Project Entry Form & Check

- 20 copies of Entry Form, **collated and three-hole punched, but not stapled.**

2. Project Information Sheet.

- 20 copies on 8 1/2" x 11", collated and three-hole punched, but not stapled.
- Maximum two (2) typed pages, reviewing significant architectural, engineering, and construction aspects of the project. Discuss both the positive effects that the project has had on the community, and the project safety record. **Pages should be collated and three-hole punched, but not stapled.**

3. Project Visuals

- 72 DPI JPG images (minimum two / maximum ten). All pictures should be accompanied by a keyed caption sheet and a photo release. All Rehab Category entries **must** include both "before" and "after" photos.

DEADLINE

All Merit Award entries must be received at the CBC office by February 5, 2010.

Late entries will not be accepted.

JUDGING

Finalists will be requested to submit story boards of their projects, which will be showcased at the 2010 Merit Awards Dinner.

Finalists in all six categories will be determined in March and notified accordingly. Judging of the finalists will take place in April 2010, and results will be announced at the Merit Awards Dinner on May 19, 2010.
