SPEAKER PROFILE:

JAMES UNDERWOOD

Deputy Director, Illinois Capital Development Board

Jim Underwood was named Deputy Director of Construction for the Capital Development Board (CDB) on September 2, 2008. He previously served as Chief Executive Officer for Illinois Correctional Industries and as Personnel Manager for the Illinois Department of Corrections for about a year prior to that. At the Secretary of State's Office, he worked as Maintenance and Construction Division Chief for the State Capital complex.

Underwood began as an electrician with a four-year Apprenticeship at IBEW Local 146 in Decatur in 1978. He served as Assistant Business Manager for Local 146 for five and a half years and earned a B.A. in Labor Studies in 2000. As Deputy Director of Construction, Underwood oversees all activity on non-road, state-funded construction projects.

As the construction management agency for Illinois government since 1972, the Capital Development Board builds new state facilities, such as prisons, college & university classroom buildings, state offices, mental health hospitals, and state parks. It oversees renovation projects at 8,441 state-owned Illinois buildings which contain more than 96 million square-feet of floor space.

The agency works with the Illinois State Board of Education to administer grants for school construction and renovation at local elementary and secondary school districts through the School Construction Program. In that role, the CDB removes hazardous materials such as asbestos and lead from state-owned facilities, replaces leaking underground storage tanks on state property, and the remodels state buildings to accommodate disabled access.

Established to better manage the state's capital improvement programs, the Agency is guided by a 7-member, bi-partisan board that deliberates matters of policy, approves the selection of design professionals, and establishes policy direction. All CDB Board Members are appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Illinois Senate to serve four-year, unpaid terms. In turn, they select their Executive Director, who is then responsible for the daily operation and management of the Agency and its employees.
